

SMART GOALS 2015-16

How many SMART Goals do I have?

Each Staff member is responsible for 2 SMART goals.

- 1. Professional Goal →PLC (Data Team) goal
- 2. Personal Goal → Student Growth/Instruction



One of these goals must encompass a Blended and/or Personalized Learning goal

Example of Blended Learning Goal:

I will <u>implement</u> a <u>flexible approach to student assessment monthly</u> into my instructional practice during the 2015-16 school year in order to increase student growth.

- 1. How am I currently meeting this goal in my classroom?
- 2. Do I assess this goal already?
- 3. Is this goal attainable and relevant / results oriented?
- 4. Does it improve student learning?

More Examples of Possible SMART Goals

- 1. (PLC-Professional) I will implement a common assessment quarterly into my instructional practice during the 2015-16 school year in order to increase content consistency and student growth.
- 2. (PLC-Blended) I will employ student-to-student collaboration twice a month into my instructional practice during the 2015-16 school year in order to improve student work that is greater than the sum of its parts.
- 3. (Personal-Blended) I will implement an instructional strategy integrating an iPad application quarterly during the 2015-16 school year in order to increase student engagement.
- 4. (Personal) I will attend 2-5 professional development courses during the 2015-16 school year in order to increase my technological aptitude by incorporating newly gained techniques into my instructional practice.
- 5. (Personalized) I will implement a student choice project/assessment quarterly during 2015-16 school year in order to increase student driven learning.
- 6. (Personalized) I will implement student success plans where students choose their learning goals and action steps quarterly during the 2015-16 school year to increase student's ownership of their learning.
- 7. (Blended) I will implement one canvas lesson per semester during the 2015-16 school year in order to provide greater access and flexibility of lessons to all learners.
